

# Diversitat Youth Education



## Eligibility:

Diversitat Youth Education is an alternative education setting to mainstream schooling for young people aged 15-19. There are no pre-requisites for entry into the program. The Xpress and SWEET programs are a Centrelink recognised full-time youth activity.

## Support in program:

Diversitat Youth Education provides a full-time Welfare Support Person for all students to access. Support is offered through counselling, agency referrals and general classroom assistance. Students are regularly provided education feedback in the classroom and through interviews and reports. Parent/Guardian communication is welcome. Successful completion of the course is subject to satisfactory attendance and participation.

## Where to from here:

Students enrolled in Diversitat Youth Education are given support in finding a suitable and achievable pathway once finished their enrolment in the program. Our industry experienced Community Placements Coordinator will provide one-on-one support to find a pathway. Work experience is available to eligible students.

## Xpress Program



### The Program:

The Xpress Program offers students a fun, hands-on curriculum with a strong focus on literacy and numeracy skills building. Students are given extra support to build confidence and achieve success with literacy and numeracy.

The Xpress program caters for varying abilities and learning styles in the classroom. Students will be enrolled in accredited certificates: Certificate in General Education for Adults (Intro/I/II/III); Certificate I in Vocational Preparation & Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL).

### Classes:

Classes are run on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday throughout the school year. Class sizes are small with a maximum of 13 students enrolled in each homegroup. Subjects studied include: Literacy, Numeracy, Health, Art, Career Planning, & Work Related Skills, Sport, Band & Personal Development.

## SWEET Program



### The Program:

The SWEET Program offers students the opportunity to design their course around their career plans with a strong focus on preparing students for the workforce and on pathway planning.

The SWEET program caters for varying abilities and learning styles in the classroom. Students will be enrolled in accredited certificates: Certificate in General Education for Adults (Intro/I/II/III); Certificate I in Vocational Preparation & Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL).

### Classes:

Classes are run on a Wednesday, Thursday and Friday throughout the school year. Class sizes are small with a maximum of 13 students enrolled in each homegroup. Subjects studied include: Work Related Skills, Career Planning, Personal Development Skills, Literacy, Numeracy, Art, Sport and Media.
